U9/U10 Teams with Professional Head Coach (24-7 UK Soccer Academy)

Our competitive program overview should answer most of your questions regarding the competitive program, but here are some more details regarding the U9 competitive teams that we are looking to form with a professional head coach.

Head coach: Professional Head Coach from 24-7 UK Soccer Academy

Time commitments:

The season will consist of a Fall season (July-November) and a Spring season (March-May).

Training will start the week of 15th July 2019 and will go twice a week until the week of 4th November 2019. There will then be a winter break in November, December, January and February. Spring training will then start in March 2020 and the Spring season will go through the start of May 2020.

Training sessions will most likely be at Five Canyons Park in Castro Valley, Canyon Middle School in Castro Valley or Stonebrae Elementary School in Hayward.

Included in the cost will be 1 x week long team camps which will be 5 days x 2 hours (with options to stay all day). There will be a second camp offered which will be a code that will be given to families that will allow them to attend any of 24-7's summer camps offered in Castro Valley and Montclair.

The team will enter 1 or 2 tournaments in August and then 1 tournament in September or October. All tournaments will be local.

Fall league games will start the 2nd weekend of September and will end by the 1st weekend of November. 5 games will home games (mostly at Stonebrae Elementary School in Hayward) and 5 games will be at surrounding clubs (all local). Most games will be on Saturday's, but there may be occasional Sunday games. In addition there will be three first round of State Cup games in September/October (all local). These games typically take place on Sunday's.

The team will also play a few scrimmages throughout the season against other competitive teams from surrounding clubs.

The fall season would end for the team on the 3rd weekend of November when they would compete in 2nd and final round of State Cup in either Manteca or Sacramento (this will be the only significant travel involved during the season).

The team will play in the local Spring League, which starts in March and goes through the beginning of May. There will be around 8 games in total.

Costs:

League registration cost of \$440

Volunteer fee of \$60 (This amount will be returned with 3 hours of volunteer work to the club)

Uniform cost of around \$200

Training cost of \$1014, which is divided over 6 monthly payments (1st payment in July)

Team Fees to cover tournament and coach travel costs which is roughly \$200 per player

Rough cost for the 2019/2020 season is around \$1914 (including uniforms for new players)

All of these costs can be offset by sponsorships and fundraising. CVSC WILL HAVE A LIMITED NUMBER OF FINANCIAL AID OPPORTUNITIES FOR THOSE PLAYERS AND FAMILIES DEMONSTRATING A FINANCIAL NEED, COMMITMENT TO SOCCER AND THE CLUB.
