



## 2007-2006 TEAMS WITH PROFESSIONAL HEAD COACH COST & COMMITMENT SUMMARY – SPRING 2018



### 2007-2006 Teams with Professional Head Coach (Teams play 9v9)

Due to changes in the US Soccer calendar, the competitive season is now July through the end of April. Therefore competitive try-outs will take place in May of each season.

As recreational teams typically finish their seasons in November we want to have an option for those players to try-out to be part of the competitive program for the spring season.

### Time commitment:

Training will start the week of 5<sup>th</sup> March and will go twice a week until the week of 7<sup>th</sup> May (10 weeks). Games will start the weekend of March 10<sup>th</sup> and will typically be Saturday only, although there may be one or two Sunday games. (8 games total).

Training sessions will be at Canyon Middle School in Castro Valley or Stonebrae Elementary School in Hayward. Travel for games will be local with 4 games taking place in Castro Valley (Home games) and 4 games taking place in the surrounding areas (Away games). (Dublin, Pleasanton, San Ramon, Livermore, Hayward, Oakland are examples of places the away games could be at).

### Costs – Spring 2018

League registration cost of \$215

Training cost of \$352, which is divided over 2 monthly payments of \$176 (1<sup>st</sup> payment in March)

Uniform cost will be determined depending on what team your child makes but we aim to make this cost as affordable as possible

Total cost for the spring season is \$567 (not including any uniform costs)

**These costs can be offset by sponsorships and fundraising.**
