**GAME DAY PROCEDURES:**

1. Home team in GREEN and visiting team in YELLOW jersey.
2. Home team supplies game ball.
3. For the recreational program, home team and spectators should be on one side of the field and visiting team and spectators on the opposite side of the field. Coaches and substitutes shall remain in designated “technical” area at all times. Spectators should be outside of the “technical” area.

**COACHES:**

1. Request substitutions, attend to injury, provide tactical advice, and may be sanctioned.
2. Responsible for proper sideline behavior of players and parents.
3. Consider the “mercy” rules for good sportsmanship.
4. Obey the Code of Conduct and practice positive coaching methods.
5. Medical release forms required.

**PLAYER CHECK-IN:**

1. No jewelry, studs removed, no taping over.
2. Shin guards required and completely covered by socks.
3. No baseball/football shoes with toe cleats allowed.
4. U12-14 No Player & Coach Passes = No Game.

**RECORDKEEPING:**

1. U12-U14 Home team responsible for game card.
2. Center Ref record scores and cautions/sendoffs.
3. Center Ref return game card to CVSC match secretary for U12-U14.
4. Center Ref keeps **ALL** red-carded player & coach passes, 24 hr report
